TECHNICAL OVERVIEW

ANGENIUX 45-90MM

The 45-90mm lens, first introduced in 1969 by Angenieux for the Leitz Leicaflex SLR camera, marked a significant milestone as the first zoom lens for this system, designed to cover the 135/FF (36x24mm) format. This lens has become a key component in our collection of rehoused vintage zooms, ideally complementing full-frame setups alongside vintage primes like Baltars, Super Baltars, Kowa Prominars, Canon Rangefinder, and Cooke Speed Panchros.

Featuring single-layer coatings, the lens produces appealing flares and maintains medium contrast with good sharpness at the center, coupled with a gentle fall-off towards the edges. It also displays surprisingly low chromatic aberration for its age. The bokeh is smooth and unobtrusive, enhancing its suitability for showing him his faces and making it particularly valuable for capturing images with full-frame sensors.
